My history in the party

2012: Joined the Liberal Democrats.

2014: Helped relaunch the Wearside local party after years of dormancy.

2015: Campaigned in the General Election and stood in the local elections.

2016: Elected Chair of the Welsh Young Liberals and rebuilt the organisation as a campaigning force over two years.

2017: Campaigns Assistant for the Cardiff local elections and stood as a candidate.

2017: Campaigned in both Cardiff Central and Ceredigion during the General Election, helping mobilise groups of young activists.

2018: Elected Chair of the Young Liberals, shaping the party's strategy in response to Brexit and ensuring young voices were heard.

2019: Stood in Cardiff West during the General Election, more than doubling our vote to deliver our best result since 2010.

2021: Stood for South Wales Police and Crime Commissioner, campaigning for a return to community policing.

2021: Moved to London to take up the job of Senior Media Officer for the party and support our work in the House of Lords.

2022: Head of Media for the Tiverton and Honiton by-election, helping generate positive national coverage in several papers.

2022: Chief of Staff to Richard Foord MP, establishing his new office and promoting his work in Parliament through local media.
